Thank you for the comments you submitted on July 30, 2012 regarding the Black Range Minerals prospecting permit modification (P-2009-025, MD-02). The DRMS is conducting a review of the modification in accordance with Rule 5 of The Mineral Rules and Regulations of The Colorado Mined Land Reclamation Board for Hard Rock, Metal, and Designated Mining Operations. Should the DRMS find any deficiencies in the MD-02 application, the prospector will have 60 days from the date the prospector is notified by the DRMS of those deficiencies to address them.

As a person who filed a timely comment, you will receive a copy of the decision letter. Pursuant to Rule 5.1.3(d)(II), should you wish to appeal the determination made by the Office, you will have five (5) business days from the date the Office sends its notice in which to file such an appeal.
