Dear Mr. McClure:

I received your proposed Plan of Operations (POO) for Underground Exploration and Development Program – Bulldog Mine Project Site on July 16, 2012. The POO has been designated USFS number: POO-2012-042939-BULLDOG-UE-0209. Nicolas Sandoval, Forest Geologist, acknowledged receipt of the POO by email on August 3, 2012. In accordance with Forest Service minerals regulations, located at 36 CFR 228.5 (4) (5):

- 4) Notify the operator that the plan is being reviewed, but that more time, not to exceed an additional sixty (60) days, is necessary to complete such review, setting forth the reasons why additional time is needed: Provided, however, That days during which the area of operations is inaccessible for inspection shall not be included when computing the sixty (60) day period; or
- (5) Notify the operator that the plan cannot be approved until a final environmental statement has been prepared and filed with the Council on Environmental Quality as provided in §228.4(f).

I am requiring additional time to complete review of your plan. My staff and I will complete review within the next 30 days and will contact you at that time. I will not approve the plan until review is complete, all state and federal permits are acquired, and the appropriate analysis is conducted and finalized.
