RE: Notice of Intent to conduct prospecting operations for hard rock/metal mines, P-2011-008- Reclamation Report and request for reclamation responsibility release

Dear Mr. Oswald:

NOI P-2011-008 was approved on May 27, 2011 and Belleview Land & Mineral Co., LLC (BLMC) begun its planned exploration activities. Because of changes in the exploration program all proposed work on reopening the Homestake adit was suspended until more exploration and target definition work were completed. Small amounts of mapping and rock chip sampling were conducted on the patented claim group as well as the 34 unpatented mining claims. As a result of this work a geophysical survey was planned and implemented in the fall of 2011. In early spring, BLMC was notified by our parent company, First Solar, that the project was to be shut down and reclamation work was to commence. Completed and uncompleted aspects of the NOI are listed below:

- Closure of the Homestake adit portal (on US Forest Service land) with a DRMS approved bat access gate.
  This work was completed on May 13, 2012. A secondary access road that is on a south facing slope
  allowing winter access to the cabin on the Klondike patented claim was constructed all on BLMC
  patented claims. This road is 700 ft. in length and approximately 10 ft. wide road and is not to be
  reclaimed.
- 2. No trenches were constructed
- 3. No new roads on US Forest Service land were constructed.
- 4. No drilling of any type took place on the property.
