The Division's technical adequacy review of the above-named permit application has been underway. The Division finds that, due to the complex nature of the application, the decision date must be extended to allow staff specialists sufficient time to review the application and draft comments. This extension is allowed pursuant to Hard Rock/Metal Mining Rule 1.4.1(7).

The original decision date was set for October 15, 2012. It has been extended for up to 60 days, and is now reset for December 14, 2012.
