The sixth annual TransRockies run kicks off in Buena Vista Aug. 14 and will feature the "Bachelor" Ryan Sutter.

The race begins at 9 a.m. and will cover 116 miles over six days, ending in Beaver Creek on Aug. 19. Sutter, the reality-television star from the first season of "The Bachelor," is set to compete in the event.

Runners will start from East Main Street and finish the first stage north of town at Railroad Bridge. Stage two will take runners from Vicksburg to Twin Lakes. Stage three covers Leadville to Camp Hale, before continuing on to Red Cliff for the end of stage four. Stage five goes to Vail before the final stage continues to Beaver Creek. Runners will gain nearly 20,000 feet in elevation.

The course and itinerary is preliminary, according to the TransRockies website, and may change before the race.

Race packets can be picked up in town in the afternoon on Aug. 13, or last minute at 7 a.m. on race day.

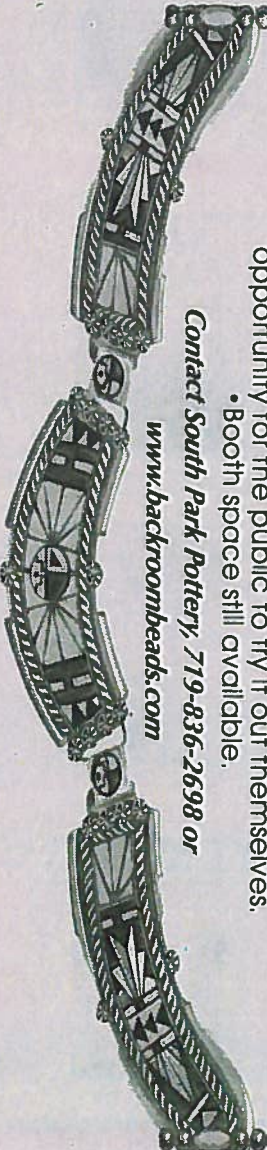
