Hi Michael,

I'm glad we got to talk this morning about the change from the concrete portal to the timber set portal. I will be meeting tomorrow with Shannon and Patrick Murphy and we will cover your latest letter. I will have to say the figures you use in item # 2 are way too high. We will measure the existing disturbed area

carefully. This historic mine dump has not changed in size since 1939 when the mine last operated and we do not expect to change the size of the dump with the prospecting activities. The cost to cover the historic mine area is far less than the \$ 58,000 figure your letter indicates.

As I stated this morning the material to backfill the portal area upon closure is readily available right at the portal area.

We will provide you with a letter no later than Wednesday to address the top soil square footage.
