Requested Additional Design and Analysis Data to Support the Assertion that Mill Vibrations and  
Settling of Foundation Material Will Not Reduce the Function of the New Proposed SGVLF**

Dear Mr. Dubois:

On September 28, 2012 the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) received the risk evaluation report from Lidstone and Associates, Inc (Lidstone) summarizing their review of the subject design and analysis data.

Based on Lidstone's summary report, the conditions set forth under Stipulation No. 25 have been met. As such, CC&V may proceed with placement of the liner system that is related to the construction of the new mill and the SGVLF.

The Division considers the conditions set forth under both Amendment 10 stipulations (Nos. 24 and 25) have now been met. No further action is required by CC&V with respect to Stipulation Nos. 24 and 25. However, pursuant to Rule 7.3.2(2), the Division requires CC&V to submit engineering certification reports for the mill platform, the high grade mill and the SGVLF liner system upon construction completion of these environmental protection facilities.
