OBSERVATIONS

This inspection was conducted by the Colorado Division of Reclamation, Mining, and Safety (Division) as a follow up to document work done to reduce the reclamation liability on site prior to submission of an increase. In April of 2012 the Division did a normal review of the reclamation liability estimate. The review resulted in a substantial increase due to two factors. The first was inflation as the bond had not been reviewed in several years. The second is the liability for backfilling almost 3200 linear feet of highwall within the pit not previously addressed in other estimates.

The Angie Pit is a 112c permitted site located south of the Redvale in Western Colorado. No representative for Williams Construction accompanied the inspector on site.

The inspector noted that the working face along the northwest had been reduced down to 3:1 slopes. Other areas along the west side appeared to have been regarded and sloped. These areas will be removed from the reclamation liability estimate.

A loader was observed stacking some material along the northeast highwall although it did not appear to be slope reduction work. The large majority of the increase in the bond is due to the highwall that transverses from northwest to southeast and along the south permit boundary lines. Williams did not do any work in these areas over the summer as suggested. Some areas are partially backfilled but none are complete enough to consider acceptable for liability reduction purposes.

The financial warranty was last updated in 2008. Based on current conditions the review is adjusted and updated with accepted tasks and values. The update is addressed by separate cover and due January 4, 2013.
