

### PUBLIC MEETING NOTICE

The San Miguel County Board of County Commissioners has initiated a Call Up of the final decision of the County Planning Commission regarding an application submitted by Identity Towers for a 150-foot tall Telecommunication Tower and Facilities on a 52-acre parcel owned by Robert and Ralph Weaver, located just north of the San Miguel County Fairgrounds and Norwood School, zoned Wright's Mesa (WM). The Call Up Procedure is a Board of County Commissioners Review pursuant to Land Use Code, Section 1-29. Call Up of Land Use Decision by the Planning Commission.

The purpose and basis for the Call Up is to allow the Board of County Commissioners to obtain additional information from Identity Towers and AT&T, the call phone carrier, and to address with them specifically a number of questions and concerns that were raised at the Planning Commission meeting but were not answered. The questions and concerns have to do with current coverage and AT&T's obligation to improve cell service, how the proposed installation fits into the larger telecommunications network and the potential options in terms of visual impacts and the best engineering and coverage options for a new cell phone tower to serve Norwood and Wright's Mesa. The Board has also asked the applicant to evaluate the feasibility or viability of locating the proposed new cell tower in the general vicinity of the Uncompahgre Medical Clinic.

A public meeting on the above proposal will be held by the Board of County Commissioners on November 7, 2012 at 6:00 PM at the Norwood Community Center, 1670 Natuna Street, Norwood, Colorado. The Call Up Procedure allows the Board of County Commissioners to evaluate all written materials submitted to the County Planning Commission as well as additional information or materials that may be submitted prior to or during the scheduled meeting.

Written comments of more than one page may not receive complete consideration if not received by NOON October 31, 2012. Send written comments to: San Miguel County Planning Department, P.O. Box 648, Telluride, CO 81435.
