Dear Mr. Schafer:

On November 16, 2012 The Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) received the 110 Construction Materials Reclamation Permit Application Package for the Pickard Pit, file No. M-2012-048. On December 10, 2012, the Division received the total amount for the application fee. The preliminary review of the application package determined that the following items must be received before the Division can consider your application as being submitted and technical review can begin:

6.3.5 Exhibit E-Map

1) Mining Plan Map

Outline and label existing disturbances within and/or adjacent to the permit boundary (e.g, previously mined areas).

2) Reclamation plan Map

State the average thickness of replaced overburden by reclamation area or phase.

6.3.7 Exhibit G Source of Legal Right-to-Enter.

3) Provide a description of the basis for legal right to enter to the site and conduct mining and reclamation. This rule states that the letter needs to be notarized. Also, the terminology used should refer to the right to mine, rather than to the right to "explore".

All other required items appear to be present in the submitted application package. Please provide two sets of the items listed above. Until we receive the items that are presently lacking we cannot process the application further. Please provide the requested material within 60

days of the date of this letter, or the application may be denied. Once we have received these items we can call the application complete and begin the 30-day adequacy review.

Materials may be sent directly to the Division's office in Denver.
