Mr. Guire:

My original response addressed the situation where a party objected to the Division's proposed decision to release a certain portion of the performance bond. A party's only recourse at that point is to request an adjudicatory hearing.

Your follow-up question seems refer instead to the Division's proposed decision itself, i.e. what if the Division does not include the Burbridge parcel in the proposed decision for bond release? That determination would have to be made through the bond release process as described in the Rules; unfortunately, there are too many unknowns for me to hypothesize about that particular scenario.

Please let me know if I have misinterpreted your question.
