Dear Mr. Cazier,

Please accept the following as response to above reference DRMS review.

Application:

- Item I, page 1: Please accept a replacement page with corrected spelling of Prospector's name.
- 2. Item III, 9 page 3: The electronic form does not allow units entry into the form.
- 3. Item III 9, page 3. The maximum volume of material to be transported off site is 5 tons.
- Item III 10, page 3: The prospector is not expecting to blast but commits to submitting a modification to the NOI in the event blasting becomes necessary due to rock structures.
- 5. Item III 11, page 4 The proposed 200 maximum linear feet of trenching will be approximately 3 feet wide and a maximum of six (6) inches deep for a maximum total overburden removal of approximately 11 tons, significantly less than 50 tons. The potential trench area is currently exposed in existing mountain roads. Should overburden increase beyond expected, no trenching will occur and the area will be explored by drilling.
- Item III 12, page 4. The prospector commits to providing borehole drill logs for the purpose of determining appropriate borehole abandonment procedures in accordance with Rule 5.4.
- 7. Item IV 11, page 6: The prospector accepts the responsibility for reclaiming the proposed 800 linear feet of new mountain trail in the event it is constructed. The prospector accepts the inclusion of the proposed trail in the reclamation bond.

Enclosed is proof of mailing to Board of County Commissioners and CPW comments following the bat survey.

Lastly, Zephyr is scheduled to commence exploration February 20, 2013. Please let me know what additional documents are required by the Division to meet this deadline.
