COMMENTS

This was a partial inspection of the Munger Canyon Mine conducted by Mike Boulay of the DRMS Grand Junction Field Office on February 27, 2013. There was no operator/representative from Munger Canyon Mine present during the inspection. Weather conditions were partly cloudy and cold. The ground was snow covered from the storm that occurred prior to the inspection.

The mine site access road off of Highway 139 was deemed unsafe to travel on due to snow packed and icy conditions. The access road had not been plowed. There was no activity at the mine site and it did not appear that any one has attempted to travel onto the access road since the recent snowstorm.

The mine identification sign with operator information, DRMS Permit Number and MSHA ID is in good condition and clearly visible at the gated entrance to the site. See attached photograph at the end of this inspection report.

OFFSITE SUPPORT FACILIITES - Rule 4.04, 4.28:

The reclaimed Loma Loadout site was inspected. The site was entirely snow packed. There is no activity at the site and it remains in good condition. No problems were identified with this inspection.
