RE: Second Notice of Incomplete Application, AM-01, SAKO (ZMK) Pit, Permit No. M-1991-146.

Dear Mr. Larson:

On December 24, 2012, the Division received an application for Amendment No. 1 (AM-01) at the SAKO Pit. The application was deemed incomplete for the purposes of filing. The Division identified the deficiencies of the application in a correspondence dated January 2, 2013. On March 4, 2013, the Division received response to the deficiency issues raised by the Division. The Division has reviewed the materials received March 4, 2013, and has identified the following deficiencies for AM-01. Pursuant to Rules 1.1(20.1) and 1.4.2, the following items must be received before the Division can consider your application as being filed and commence the technical review.

 On the bottom of page 7 of the application form, the signature of the registered agent of SAKO Excavation LLC must be properly notarized. However, in this second iteration of the application the notary notarized her own signature and not the signature of the applicant. The correction is illustrated in Attachment 1, attached to this correspondence. The Division will not accept an application with error in the portion completed by the notary. Please submit a properly executed application form.

NOTE: The notary's error was repeated on both of the damage compensation agreements for the structure owned by Jim Bob Hobbs. The error on the damage compensation agreements is not a filing deficiency but will be raised by the Division as an adequacy issue during the technical review process, if not corrected before the application is considered complete for the purposes of filing.

 Pursuant to Rule 1.6.2(1)(c), a complete copy of the application, including all exhibits except for confidential items, if any, must be placed at the County Clerk and Recorder's Office. Therefore, please submit an updated Exhibit I, Proof of Filing with County Clerk, verifying a correctly executed application form has been placed with the County Clerk and Recorder's Office, in addition to the materials previous placed at that office.

The 60-day deadline for filing AM-01 occurred on March 4, 2013. Failure to resolve the deficiency items identified in this correspondence will cause the Division to deny the application, pursuant to Rule 1.4.1(8). Please resolve the above listed deficiencies within two weeks, by March 21, 2013.
