***Re: Notice of Temporary Cessation: Permit Site and Numbers: Hawkeye Mine, M-1978-311, Ellison Mine, M-1978-342, Burros Mine, M-1977-297, and JD-5 Mine, M-1977-248.***

On March 1, 2013 the Division of Reclamation, Mining, and Safety received Gold Eagle Mining Company's notice of temporary cessation (TC). This letter is sent pursuant to the requirement of Rule 1.13.6 (1) of the Rules and Regulations of the Colorado Mined Land Reclamation Board.

The first period of temporary cessation will commence on January 4, 2013 and will last up to five years from that date until January 4, 2018. The notice submitted to the Division contains information pertaining to the reasons for cessation of the mining operation, a plan for resumption, and the measures taken to comply with reclamation and other necessary activities related to the performance standards of Rule 3 of the Rules and Regulations in order to maintain the mine in a non-producing or non-development state.

The Notice of Temporary Cessation will be placed on the monthly agenda of the April 17~18, 2013 meeting of the Mined Land Reclamation Board. During that meeting, the Board may consider acceptance of the notice so long as there are no issues with performance or reclamation standards via inspection, file review, and no concerns are expressed by interested persons who would be adversely affected or aggrieved.

Written comments regarding the matter must be submitted to the Division by no later than 5:00 PM, April 16, 2013.
