In response to your letter dated May 24, 1994, we have reviewed the agreement between Turnpike Construction Company, Cinque Land Company and the Water Users Association of District No. 6 and have the following comments and requests:

Based on information supplied by you and Gary Curtiss of Division of Minerals and Geology, the estimated exposed water surface is approximately 30 acres, all within the Phase I area identified on Exhibit A attached to the agreement. Please provide an aerial photo confirming the extent of the exposed water surface within the Phase I area. Additionally, provide the size of the exposed water area.

A copy of the stock certificate for the five shares of the capital stock of the Boulder and White Rock Ditch and Reservoir Company must be endorsed in accordance with §3b of the agreement. Copies of the endorsed certificate need to be sent to this office as well as the Water Users Association of District 6.

In accordance with §37-90-137(11)(a)(i), C.R.S., the agreement with the Water Users Association of District No. 6 is valid and therefore no additional information beyond the above requests will be required. Please provide the information requested above within 30 days of receipt of this letter.
