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COMMENTS

This was a complete inspection of the Bear No. 3 Mine conducted by Susan Burgmaier of DRMS. No representative of Bear Coal Company was present during the inspection. Weather conditions at the time of the inspection were clear and warm; ground conditions were muddy.

The permit for the mine expired on July 19, 2012, and the operator did not apply for renewal of the permit.

There were tire tracks through the mud of the facilities area; it appeared that a vehicle had driven through the facilities area to the east end of the permit area.

AVAILABILITY OF RECORDS – Rule 5.02.4(1):

Records were inspected at the Bowie Resources, LLC office. Required records were available but had not been updated since the mine permit expired.

Backfilled slopes did not exhibit any signs of recent movement or instability.

The sedimentation pond was dry. The seep at the base of the portal slope slide was flowing about 1-2 gpm into the treatment pond which was discharging to the North Fork of the Gunnison River.

The interface of the bridge with the east bank of the North Fork continues to erode, and a hole approximately 3' x 5' has opened on the south abutment corner. Smaller holes, around 1-2' in diameter are exposed on the other three corners. The hole on the southeast end is large enough for a vehicle tire to fall through.
