Hi Tyler good to talk to you earlier. I looked at all three applications we talked about. As follows:

M-1979-163 Shannon Pit - no 404 permit required from our office and no further comments from me unless applicant wants a letter confirming this.

M-2013-008 Precious Mine - I need more clarification on the Em. Spillway and 4" pipe (primary spillway) identified on Map C-2: Mining Extents. These features are located on the southwest corner of the mine area/southwest corner of the sediment pond. Normally sediment ponds for mining do not have an outlet to a water channel. Especially if the pond contains hazardous materials and/or contaminated water from mineral exposure and leaching like acid mine drainage, etc. This outlet under normal circumstances would require permitting from our office, but we cannot issue a permit if its anything but surface water and storm drainage. I need to talk to responsible party to investigate this further. If you have contact info for this handy I would appreciate it and please send.

M-1992-076 S Bar C Farms Pit - I spoke to the applicant to clarify and no 404 permit required from our office and no further comments from me.

Thanks and let me know about the Precious Mine if you have it.
