#### **OBSERVATIONS**

This inspection was conducted as part of the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety monitoring program. Present at the inspection were Kate Pickford, DRMS, and Lonnie Pribble, landowner and county representative.

The site is fully disturbed due to mining related activities. Stockpiles of topsoil, overburden and crushed gravel are distributed throughout the permit area. There is vegetative material on the pit floor that Mr. Pribble indicates is periodically burned and will not be buried.

No problems were observed during this inspection.
