COMMENTS

This was a partial inspection of the Bear No. 3 Mine based on aerial photographs of the site taken by Harry Ranney and reviewed by Susan Burgmaier of DRMS. Weather conditions at the time of the inspection were clear; ground conditions appeared to be muddy around the facilities area.

The permit for the mine expired on July 19, 2012, and the operator did not apply for renewal of the permit.
