## **OBSERVATIONS**

This inspection was conducted as part of the normal monitoring program established by the Colorado Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety. The Pit 500 is located off of Highway 141 approximately 0.5 miles south of Whitewater, Colorado. The Pit 500 is a multi phase operation that consists of two separate locations that are divided by the Gunnison River. The purpose of the May 3, 2013 inspection was to assess the success of the reclamation success in Stage 2 – Part A and Stage 2 – Part B to and determine if the reclamation was completed according to what is required in the approved reclamation plan. Mark and Ed Gardner of Whitewater Building Materials Corp. accompanied the inspector during the inspection.

Conditions Observed in Stage 2 – Part A – This Portion of the permitted area is owned by Shawn Ridgley. All sloping appeared to be no steeper than the required 3H:1V. Adequate vegetation was observed.


**Conditions Observed in Stage 2 – Part B** – This Portion of the permitted area is owned by James McCurter. All sloping appeared to be no steeper than the required 3H:1V. The adequate vegetation was observed.


This inspection was focused primarily on the reclamation release request and other components of the mining operation were not formally addressed during the inspection.


