OBSERVATIONS

This inspection was conducted as part of the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety monitoring program.

This site is still actively being mined. Phases 1, 2, and 3 are mined out and being used as the processing and stockpile areas. Another phase is in reclamation, with completion of the grading of the slopes currently being addressed. Active mining is occurring in yet another phase. In the actively mined phase, there are vertical highwalls on three sides of the excavation.

All activity at the site is within the guidelines of the permit. A bond calculation was conducted resulting in a surety increase. The information related to the increase is included with this report.
