Victory Way, Craig, CO, 81625, phone number (970) 824-5517, has filed an application for a Regular (112) Construction Materials Operation Reclamation Permit with the Colorado Mined Land Reclamation Board under the provisions of the Colorado Mined Land Reclamation Act for the Extraction of Construction Materials.

The proposed mine is known as the Refuge Pit No. 1 (Conversion No. 1), and is located at or near Section 10, Township 10 North, Range 103 West, of the 6th Prime Meridian.

The proposed date of commencement is October 1, 2013, and the proposed date of completion is October 1, 2033. The proposed future use of the land is Rangeland.
