OBSERVATIONS

This inspection was conducted due to a Succession of Operator application received for the site.

The site consists of two portions. The processing area is located on the west side of the Animas River and the extraction area is located on the east side. The operation has an Army Corps permit which allows for the installation of a river crossing during the low water season. Each spring, the low water crossing and culverts are removed. The processing area contains multiple buildings, storage, a cement plant and multiple stockpiles. The post milning land use for this portion of the permit is Commercial/Industrial, so the buildings are allowed to remain. The post mining land use for the extraction area is Developed Water Resource.

Mining is occurring on the east side of the permit, with concurrent reclamation.

A bond calculation was conducted and a bond increase is necessary for the site. Information regarding the bond increase is included with this report.
