OBSERVATIONS

This inspection was conducted as part of the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety's (Division) normal monitoring program. Marylin Diamond, representing the Operator, was present during this inspection. Photographs are included with this report in order to illustrate some of the conditions observed.

The Pit No. One mine is located approximately 3.3 miles southeast of Buena Vista and accessed from CR 301. The site is a 110c operation that includes a total of 9.61 permitted acres. The Division currently holds a financial warranty amount of \$18,835.00 for this site. The required financial warranty was updated following the Division's last inspection in 2012. Little to no additional disturbance has occurred at the site since that time, so the financial warranty is assumed to be adequate. The operator's most recent annual report appears to accurately portray the current site conditions.

Adequate mine identification signage was noted at the entrance to the site, and the affected area was adequately marked.

Mining activity was not occurring during this inspection.

No problems or violations were noted during this inspection.
