On June 7, 2013, this office received notification of the approval of your Colorado Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (CDRMS) application SL-01 for your Martin Mesa mining notice / NOI project (BLM case file # COC – 73288, CDRMS permit # P-2008-058) which effectively releases the reclamation bond of \$6,450.00.

We have concurred with the CDRMS's inspection report findings regarding reclamation and bond release.
