PUBLIC NOTICE

Western Fuels-Colorado, A Limited Liability Company (WFCO), 12050 N. Peoria St., Suite 100, Westminster, CO 80234 has filed with the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety an application for a Technical Revision to the New Horizon North Mine Permit No. C-2010-089. This Technical Revision will consist of the addition of small areas to the permit in response to CV-2013-003 and in preparation for future maintenance work.

The New Horizon North Mine office is located at 27846 West 5th Street, P.O. Box 628, Nucla, Colorado. The permit area contains tracts of land located in Section 25 and Section 36, Township 47 North, Range 16 West of the New Mexico Principal Meridian, Montrose County, CO, being more particularly described as follows:

The West 1/4 of Section 25, T. 47 N. R. 16 W. of the New Mexico Principal Meridian, containing 317.23 acres more or less, together with a tract of land 50 feet in width in Section 36, connecting the South Line of Section 25 and the northerly line of the New Horizon 2 permit boundary, containing 4.95 acres more or less. In total, the New Horizon North permit boundary contains 322.18 acres more or less.

The above mentioned tracts of land are shown on USGS 7.5 minute Nucla Quadrangle map.

A copy of the complete technical revision application is available for public inspection at the Montrose County Courthouse Annex, Nucla, Colorado. Written comments or objections to the application may be submitted to the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety, Room 215, 1313 Sherman Street, Denver, Colorado 80202, Telephone (303) 866-3567. Written comments and objections must be received by the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety within 10 days after the publication of the above notice.
