OBSERVATIONS

This inspection was conducted as part of the normal monitoring program established by the Colorado Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety. The N of Douglas Pass site is located 30 miles north of Loma, Colorado off of Highway 139. The site is a 110c operation that consists of 9.59 acres.


The mine identification sign and permit boundary markers were in place and in compliance with Rule 3.1.12. The mine identification sign was located at the entrance to the site.

The pit is currently active. The Annual Report indicated that material was excavated in 2012 and evidence of recent excavation was observed at the site. No equipment was staged at the site. A stockpile of gravel was observed on the pit floor near the entrance to the site. It appeared that minimal activity occurred at the site and material is mined on an as needed basis.

No problems or possible violations were observed during the inspection.
