OBSERVATIONS

This joint surety release inspection was conducted by the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division), the U.S Department of Energy (DOE), and the U.S. Bureau of Land Management (BLM). Ed Cotter and Kyle Turley were present on behalf of the DOE, and Rob Ernst was present on behalf of the BLM. Race Fisher, representing the Operator, was also present during this inspection. Photographs are included with this report in order to illustrate some of the conditions observed.

The C-CM-24 prospecting site is located on Club Mesa, west of Uravan, and accessed from U-16 Road. The Division holds a \$100.00 financial warranty for this project. A \$5,000.00 bond was posted with DOE.


Eight boreholes were drilled during this project. According to the operator's final report groundwater was not encountered in any of the holes. The holes were backfilled with cuttings, plugged with expanding foam, and covered with native material prior to seeding. No signs of settling of any of the backfilled holes were observed. Vegetation on the disturbed areas was sparse, but is consistent with the surrounding area. No problems were noted during this inspection.
