The following inspection topics were identified as having Problems or Possible Violations. 1. INSPECTION TOPIC: Revegetation

PROBLEM/POSSIBLE VIOLATION: Problem: There are state-listed noxious weeds present on site. This is a problem for failure to employ weed control methods for state listed noxious weed species within the permitted area, and to reduce the spread of weeds to nearby areas as required by Section 3.1.10 (6) of the Rules.

CORRECTIVE ACTIONS: Implement approved weed control plan and provide proof to the Division that this has been done. If a weed control plan is not already in place, the operator shall develop a weed control and management plan in accordance with Section 3.1.10 (6) of the Rules. This plan should be developed in consultation with the county extension agency, or weed control district office and should include specific control measures to be applied, a schedule for when control measures will be applied and a post-treatment monitoring plan. This weed control plan shall be submitted to the Division as a Technical Revision to the approved plan with the appropriate Technical Revision fee of \$216.00 by the corrective action date.

2. INSPECTION TOPIC: Signs & Markers

PROBLEM/POSSIBLE VIOLATION: Problem: The mine identification sign was not posted at the entrance of the mine site. This is a problem for failure to post a mine identification sign as required by Section 3.1.12(1) of the Rules.

CORRECTIVE ACTIONS: The operator shall, at the entrance of the mine site, post a sign which shall be clearly visible from the access road with the following: the name of the operator, a statement that a reclamation permit for the operation has been issued by the Colorado Mined Land Reclamation Board; and the permit number. The operator shall submit photo documentation that a proper sign has been posted by the corrective action date.

OBSERVATIONS

This inspection was conducted as part of the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety's (Division) normal monitoring program. A representative for the Operator was not present during this inspection. Unsuccessful attempts were made to notify Lester Crawford of the inspection by telephone. Photographs are included with this report in order to illustrate some of the conditions observed.

The Bear River Sand and Gravel pit is located approximately one mile east of Milner and accessed from Hwy 40. The site is a 112c operation that includes a total of 25.5 permitted acres. The Division currently holds a financial warranty amount of \$14,949.14 for this site.

Adequate mine identification signage was not noted at the entrance to the site. This has been noted as a problem one page one of this report.

There was no activity occurring at the site during this inspection. Signs of any recent mining activity were not evident. The pits were not dewatered during this inspection. Slopes around the pits were left at approximate 1.5H:1V - 2H:1V slopes. Volunteer vegetation is establishing on most of the pit banks.

A significant infestation of Common mullein was observed in the stockpile area in the north part of the site. Common mullein, Bull thistle and Canada thistle were also observed in other areas throughout the site. This has been noted as a problem one page one of this report.

No other problems or violations were noted during this inspection.




Figure 2: View of the mine from Hwy. 40.




Figure 6: View facing southeast across the east pond.




Figure 7: View facing west across the west pond.
