Dear Mr. Cazier;

Per our discussion and your suggestions during our phone call earlier this morning, I am requesting one more time extension for the Providence Mining 110 permit, extending it from July 29, 2013 to August 16, 2013. We have addressed all of the comments in each of your letters dated June 26, 2013 and July 3, 2013, and sent out responses and modifications (addressed to you) via U.S. Mail yesterday, July 25, 2013. At this time, two items still remain open.

The first is the notification receipts from land owners. Providence sent out three additional notices to persons that we had originally missed in our first mailing and that you picked up in your review. One return receipt has come back, but two others still remain out. We will forward them on to you as soon as we receive them.

We have also been working on the storm water issue with the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE). They have been busy on other issues and have not yet completed their review, so we are still waiting for them. We anticipate an answer back from them in the next couple of weeks, but cannot control their schedule.

You should receive yesterday's package either today or Monday. When you start reviewing it, and if you have questions, call me first so we can clear issues up as easily as possible
