COMMENTS

This was a partial inspection of the Bowie No. 1 Mine based on aerial photographs of the site taken by Harry Ranney and reviewed by Susan Burgmaier of CDRMS. Mining at the site has ceased and most of the reclamation is complete. The operator continues to utilize the loadout area for storage and equipment staging.

Weather conditions at the time of the inspection were clear. The East Mine, West Mine, and ROM areas were photographed. No activity was observed in any of the photos.

Backfilled slopes appeared to be stable with no sign of excessive erosion or instability.
