## **OBSERVATIONS**

This inspection was conducted by the Colorado Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety as part of the normal monitoring program. The site is a 1320.10 acre sodium bicarbonate in-situ solution mine located approximately 35 miles southwest of Meeker in the Piceance Basin. The site is currently classified as a 112 Hard Rock Minerals Mine but once mining commences it will be converted to a 112d-3.

The maximum allowed disturbance is 48.10 acres and the current disturbance is approximately 2 acres. Mining has not commenced and the only operations that have taken place are the ongoing hydrology monitoring program.

All hydrology monitoring pads and wells were observed during the inspection. The hydrology pads were covered with volunteer vegetation consisting of grasses and shrubs primarily broom snakeweed, sage brush and rubber rabbit brush.

A required routine reclamation cost update will be conducted and sent under separate cover.

No problems or possible violations were observed during the inspection.

No off site damage or erosion control issues were observed.
