Dear Ms. Talvitie,

In regards to the submission of the Technical Revision 17 Application to the Carbon Junction Mine permit (CDMG PERMIT C-92-080) addressing the Notice of Violation issued on May 23, 2013 following the U.S. Department of Interior Office of Surface Mining inspection, Oakridge Energy, Inc. is requesting an additional extension from the Colorado Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety until August 26, 2013 to make the corrections you addressed in your August 15, 2013 letter to Rob Harries of Goff Engineering & Surveying, Inc. submission of Technical Revision No. 17 (TR-17) to resolve the Notice of Violation as follows:

## Abatement Step #1

Submission of requested changes to Technical Revision 17 Application to the permit that accurately represents the as-built configuration of the Carbon Junction Permanent Diversion, with supporting design details per Rule 4.05.3 along with an updated, accurate, post-mining topography and mapping for the entire permit area and a map delineating the Carbon Junction drainage area by August 26, 2013 as the work is in progress to meet these required changes in the (TR-17) submission for your approval at this time.

## Abatement Step #2

Submission of the requested changes to Technical Revision Application to the permit that presents designs and plans for reestablishment of the Upper Carbon Junction Channel, and reclamation and stabilization of the Carbon Junction Temporary Diversion and gully erosion by August 9, 2013 and the work is in progress to meet these required changes in the submission for your approval at this time.

Abatement Step #3


Oakridge Energy, Inc. will repair and stabilize the gully erosion that has formed in the Carbon Junction Temporary Diversion, in accordance with the approval of the Technical Revisions submitted to the division required by Abatement Step #2.

Abatement Step #4

Oakridge Energy, Inc. will reestablish the Upper Carbon Junction Channel in accordance with the approval of the Technical Revisions submitted to the division required by Abatement Step #2.

I appreciate your consideration of this request to make the necessary changes on the Technical Revision 17 Application. Please let me know if any additional information is required to have this request considered and granted.
