Typical Call

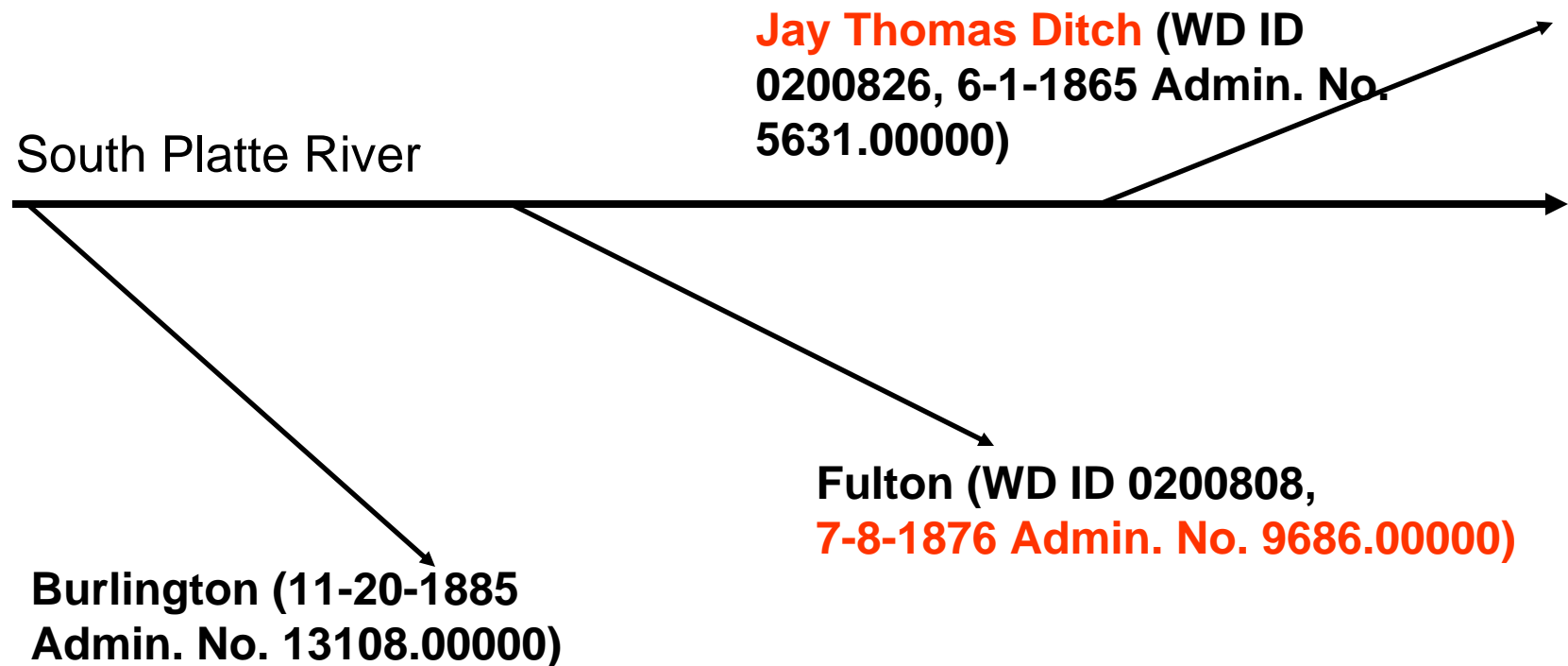
South Platte River

Typical Bypass Call

- 8-8-2006 Jay Thomas Ditch bypass call from Fulton Ditch (Fulton taking 120 cfs, 79.7 of 1865, and 40 of 74 cfs 1876 right)



We often use bypass calls so that we maximize the use and assure the user with the senior rights get their water. A

bypass exists when a user may only divert a portion of its appropriation under its priority and must bypass the remainder of the water. Instead of the

word bypass, some people use the words “swing ditch” to indicate what the ditch is that can divert a portion of its priority and pass the remainder.

DOES A CALL AFFECT MY WATER RIGHT – WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

Key 1: If the water right with the call is downstream and senior to your structure, it calls you out. Use the “Structure Name” column to determine the structure calling.

Key 2: The further you go downstream, the more junior the call.

Key 3: Do not depend on the districts affected column on the Internet.

Key 4: Depend on administration number not the appropriation date to determine a water rights priority.

DOES A CALL AFFECT MY WATER RIGHT WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW (continued)

- Must know what water district your structure is in.
- Must know what structures are in your district that are downstream of your structure.
- Must know what water districts are below your structure and in what order.

DOES A CALL AFFECT MY WATER RIGHT WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW (continued)

- Look downstream in district where your structure is located, is there a call senior to your structure?
- If not, then look in first water district downstream of district your structure is in, is there a call senior to your structure?
- Continue down the river looking at calls in different districts downstream of your structure.
