# Statutory Provisions

- Interruptible Water Supply Agreements
  - Temporarily change HCU, SEO approved,
  - Exercise three years out of ten .

# Statutory Provisions

- Instream Flow Loans
  - Temporarily change HCU, SEO approved,
  - Accelerated process,
  - Ag to ag or ag to ISF,
  - Usable for 120 days,
  - Exercise three years out of ten.

# Statutory Provisions

- Rotational Crop Management
  - Change of water right in water court, but
  - For a portion of the water right,
  - The fallowed land may be rotated.

# Statutory Provisions

- Following Leasing Pilot Projects
  - Pilot only,
  - Change the HCU of a water right,
  - CWCB-approved, State Engineer Determination of no injury,
  - From ag to myriad uses,
  - Limitations:
  - Streamlined methodology, conservative.

# Statutory Provisions

- Ag Water Protection Water Rights
  - Change the HCU to an “Agricultural Water Protection Water Right” through water court,
  - Lease, loan, or trade up to 50 percent,
  - Requires an SWSP to effectuate,
  - Must be in a conservation plan.

- Common Threads:
  - Flexibility to use water for a different use temporarily,
  - Require an HCU quantification,
    - Why again?
