Summary of Water Court Application

Application for Surface Water Rights and Change of Water Rights.

Staff Recommendation

Staff recommends that the Board ratify the filing of a Statement of Opposition filed on behalf of the Board in June 2025 to protect CWCB's instream flow water rights.

CWCB Instream Flow Water Rights

The CWCB holds water rights, including the following instream flow water rights in Water Division 3 in the Saguache River Watershed, that could be injured by this application:

Potential for Injury

- The requested alternate points of diversion for Applicants' senior water rights could injure the intervening instream flow water rights if they expand the amount of water physically or legally available to the senior water rights or expand the historical use.
- Applicants claim some water rights with appropriation dates prior to the appropriation
 of CWCB ISF water rights. The CWCB's ISF water rights may be subject to the
 beneficial uses in existence on the date of such ISF appropriations under section 37-92102(3)(b), C.R.S., so long as the uses are sufficiently demonstrated and documented.
- Terms and conditions should be included in the decree to ensure that the proposed decree will not injure the CWCB's instream flow water rights.

No other Statements of Opposition were filed in this case.
