Protect and enhance environmental attributes – The WRAP will identify environmental attributes of watersheds that are at risk from post-fire hazards and/or are in need on enhancement.

Protect and enhance recreational attributes – Recreational attributes that are associated with healthy watersheds will be identified and post-fire planning will identify projects that will benefit recreation.

Broaden South Platte communications, outreach and education programs -
