On behalf of the Colorado Water Conservation Board, I hereby request the water officials of the State of Colorado to administer in the priority system the Board’s instream flow water right on the following segment of the Colorado River, Water District 51, to preserve the natural environment to a reasonable degree.

The Colorado River at Windy Gap near Granby, CO and the Windy Gap Bypass Flume gages are in the reach and have been used to determine that flow conditions are below the minimum for the decreed water right. The Board is hereby placing a written call for said instream flow water right to ensure that the full decreed amount of this water right is made available for the decreed beneficial use of preserving the natural environment to a reasonable degree. The effective date of this call is November 9, 2018 and the call is to be in effect until March 31, 2019.
