



# Colorado Basin Roundtable Meetings for 2020

The Colorado Basin Roundtable, along with eight other Basin Roundtables and the Interbasin Compact Committee (IBCC) were created by the Colorado Legislature “**TO FACILITATE CONTINUED DISCUSSIONS WITHIN AND BETWEEN BASINS ON WATER MANAGEMENT ISSUES, AND TO ENCOURAGE LOCALLY DRIVEN COLLABORATIVE SOLUTIONS TO WATER SUPPLY CHALLENGES...**” The Basin Roundtables were instrumental in development of the recently adopted Colorado Water Plan and will play a key role in the Plan’s implementation.
