On behalf of the Colorado Water Conservation Board, I am requesting administration of Board's instream flow water right on the following segment of Washington Gulch, in Water District 59, to preserve the natural environment to a reasonable degree. Additional information about the specific ISF reach is shown below.

The Breem Ditch Headgate is located in the ISF reach and demonstrates that flow conditions are below the decreed ISF water right. The Board is requesting administration to ensure that water up to the full decreed amount of this water right is made available based on the priority system. The effective date of this call is August 11, 2020 and the call is to be in effect until the end of the current irrigation year.
