
South Platte River Basin High/Low Monthly Precipitation Summary























SOUTH PLATTE RIVER BASIN Reservoir Storage Departure from Average




























GUNNISON RIVER BASIN Reservoir Storage Departure from Average



























UPPER RIO GRANDE BASIN Reservoir Storage Departure from Average



























ARKANSAS RIVER BASIN Reservoir Storage Departure from Average











COLORADO STATEWIDE Reservoir Storage Departure from Average







Summary

•August to date has been extremely dry across the state at just 17 percent of average precipitation

•Statewide reservoir storage has generally continued to drop as it has throughout the water year

- 90 percent of average statewide
- Near to above average storage in Northern Colorado and notably below average across southern Colorado

•If the current dry conditions persist until the start of winter dry soil conditions could impact streamflows next year
